Students, you will have a one on one enrollment and graduation check meeting with your counselor. All appointments have been scheduled for you and communicated via your email. Your counselor will review a list of items that must be addressed to keep you on track for graduation. In addition, provide you with resources/information needed for college admissions requirements, testing, and other program options.

Below, is a list of items that you need to review with your parent/guardian in advance to meeting with your counselor. At the time of your meeting your counselor will be inputting your course requests for the 2020-2021 school year. You are advised to not only discuss course selections with your counselor, but also your current teacher. For example, all math teachers will be holding presentations to better inform and advise students on the senior math selection/option.

Follow these directions for the 2020-2021 Enrollment Process

- Check your email for your graduation appointment time with your counselor
- Parents/Guardians are welcome to attend your counseling appointment
- Review this application packet with your parent/guardian in its entirety prior to your appointment
- Use the graduation check list to identify courses still needed for graduation
- Review the Oklahoma State graduation requirements document
- Some courses have either a pre requisite, require an application, and/or have a fee
 associated with the course. These designations are indicated on the senior course listing
 page
- Review the pre requisite quick reference sheet for specifics
- All course descriptions may be found in the Edison Course of Study located on the Edison web page under the 2020-2021 enrollment section
- All students will follow a 4 X 4 curriculum
- If interested in off campus programs such as, job out, concurrent enrollment, and/or Tulsa technology; you MUST complete required applications by the deadline
- ALL students, which are here on a magnet transfer (71) shall abide by the school's
 magnet requirement. Students may choose either two yearlong AP courses and/or two
 concurrent enrollment courses, and/or be enrolled in an engineering or biomedical
 science program at Tulsa Technology Center. Pre AP physics and Pre Calculus will
 count as an AP offering.
- All students enrolled in an AP course are required to complete the AP contract acknowledging the rigor of the course
- ALL students must complete the Oklahoma state graduation requirements in Personal Financial Literacy and CPR
- Students interested in Leadership, Academic Peer Tutoring, Info Tech Leadership, or Careers are REQUIRED to complete an application
