- Million Dollar Throw by Mike Lupica
- Matched by Ally Condie

## **3 More Projects**

- 1. Create a <u>Double Entry Journal</u>. Divide your page in the center from the top to the bottom. On the left side of the page, write 15 direct quotes from the book including the page number. On the right side of the page, write your reflections or thoughts about each of the quotes.
- 2. Create a <u>Time Line</u> with at least 15 events that occurred in the book. It must be chronological (in order of time).
- 3. Create a <u>Venn Diagram</u> to show similarities and differences in traits of the main character and yourself. You must have at least 10 entries per section of the Venn diagram.
- 4. Create a Movie Poster for the book. It should include the following, but can include more: title of book, main characters, something from the setting, a hint of the plot, and pictures.

All four projects should be:

- ✓ In ONE manila envelope and labeled in the top right corner with: your name & book titles
