OSU ISyTE Academy Activities

At the OSU ISyTE Academy, you will spend six days on the OSU-Stillwater campus interacting with current OSU MIS students and faculty members.

Daily Field Trips and Activities You will experience activities including: OSU Camp Redlands ropes course, corporation visits, and a tour of the famous Boone Pickens Stadium.

Information Technology (IT) Exploration

The week involves several IT Exploration Modules including

Build IT--building a functional computer from parts;

Connect IT--interconnect computers into a basic network;

Code IT--write code for a Raspberry Pi 2;

Hack IT--seeing how hackers can break passwords and how to safeguard your data;

Install IT--install, from scratch, the operating system needed for activities on the machines you have built;

Explore IT--learn how technology can transport you into another world including printing in 3D;

Plug IT--set up a Raspberry Pi 2 and learn about the Internet of Things.
