




Concurrent Success Looks Like...

Admission Requirements

3.0 Unweighted Accredited High School GPA

OR

Admission Tests- Use one to meet admission requirement

ACT, or PRE-ACT, Residual ACT – Composite 19

> - SAT, or PSAT10/NMSQ – Composite 990



Enrollment Eligibility

Concurrent Enrollment Form with high school administrator signature Demonstrate College Readiness Scores through:

- ACT, residual ACT, pre-ACT
- SAT, PSAT10, PSAT-NMSQ
- Accuplacer

Benefits

Tuition Waivers

- Juniors: 6 credit hours per summer, fall, spring semester funded by TCC
- Seniors: 18 credit hours over three semesters funded by State of OK and TCC.
