APPLICANT MUST MEET ALL THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATIONS:

For High School Seniors Only. These scholarships are open to students in Tulsa Public Schools High Schools Only.

- 1. All applicants must be citizens of the United States of America.
- 2. All applicants must be active participants in their high school athletic program.
- 3. 2019 Ed Lacy Scholarship Applications must be received by the Rotary Club of North Tulsa no later than: **Friday April 3, 2020**

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants must use the ROTARY CLUB OF NORTH TULSA forms. Photocopies <u>are</u> permitted.
- 2. The Ed Lacy Scholarship Application must be completed and signed by the student, parent or guardian, and a school official.
- 3. Typewritten applications are preferred.
- 4. The application and all supporting documentation must be in the English language.
- 5. Applicants must submit a transcript of high school grades.
- 6. The Ed Lacy Scholarship recipients will be asked to attend a ceremony in their honor. Location, date, and time will be announced later. Scholarship winner(s) will be notified by the selection committee.
- 7. Please make a copy of your application for your records prior to submittal.
- 8. All scholarships issued are in the form of "Certificates of Award" by the Rotary Club of North Tulsa and are conditional upon the enrollment of the student in an under graduate four-year degree program in an accredited college or university. Upon our receipt of a "Verification of Enrollment" form from the proper school officials, a Rotary Club of North Tulsa check in the amount of the award will be forwarded to the college or university and/or Community College to establish a credit for the student.
- 9. Ed Lacy Scholarship Winners are requested to visit the Rotary Club of North Tulsa after completing their freshman year of college and make a presentation to the club.
- 10. Ed Lacy Scholarship winners are awarded a scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00.

APPLICATION ORDER:

The application must be arranged and submitted in the following order:

- 1. Complete the Rotary Club of North Tulsa Application Form.
- **2.** Write an essay on the topic, "Rotary Serving Humanity" This essay should reflect your interest, understanding and commitment to athletics, community and a profession. The minimum length of the essay is <u>350 words using Times New Romans Font.</u>
- 3. Provide your HS transcript of high school grades.
- 4. At least (2) letters of reference from a coach, teacher or mentor.

SCORING SYSTEM:

All applications are judged on a 100 point scoring system. Points are awarded in six general categories:

Athletic Performance	20
Academic Performance	20
Essay	20
Community Service	15
Leadership	15
Application Presentation	10

The judges will consist of the Ed Lacy Scholarship Committee and additional members of the Board of Directors of the Rotary Club of North Tulsa. All decisions of the judges are final and not subject to appeal.

Background: Ed Lacy was a longtime coach at Tulsa Booker T. Washington High School in a variety of coaching assignments in various sports including: tennis, wrestling, swimming, track and football. Coach Lacy led the Hornets to multiple state championships in football.

Coach Lacy emphasized the importance of students making good grades and academic achievement, and sportsmanship with the students that he led, mentored, and trained.

Coach Lacy also served as Athletic Director for Tulsa Public Schools. Coach Lacy was inducted into the Tulsa Public Schools Hall of Fame in 2013.
