operates a School-Wide Title I Program.



Definition of a Title I School:

- Title I provides federal funding to schools to help students who are economically disadvantaged and low achieving or at risk of falling behind.
- Title I is allocated to schools based on the percentage of student receiving free/reduced lunch.
 - For FY19, 57% of Edison Preparatory School students are eligible for free/reduced lunches.

School-Wide Title I School Eligibility

- The school must have at least 40% of the students eligible for free/reduced lunch.
- The school must develop a comprehensive site plan and annually review the effectiveness of the plan.
- The school uses Title I funds to upgrade the entire educational program of the school.
- Title I funds will be used to provide additional assistance to all students who experience difficulties in meeting the State's performance targets.
- The school must collect and analyze data that effects student achievement.
- Title I funds are used to serve all children in order to raise academic achievement.

2018-2019 Title I Budget

- Total Budget of \$71,000
 - 1.5 Teaching allocations (additional teachers)
 - Salary \$54,753.95
 - Benefits \$15,535.80
- Parental Involvement- \$710.25
 - Paper and postage for parental communications

Qualified Teachers

- Schools are required to notify parents if their child has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher that is not highly qualified.
 - Edison Prep has 44 certified teachers and 43 teachers are highly qualified in the subject that they are teaching.
 - There is currently 1 Edison Preparatory School teacher that is not Highly Qualified.
